100 years of tango in Copenhagen





The first 100 years of tango in Denmark was celebrated with a salute of sound and smoke. Sexteto Milonguero really fired the cannon and gave a show and performance that made the opening evening of the 9th version of Copenhagen Tango Festival memorable.

The tango comes out of the melting pot of Buenos Aires at the end of the 19th century but no one knows exactly how, where and when tango as we know it today was born.

What on the other hand we can established is the first time tango was introduced to the public in Copenhagen, namely in 1913 at the famous Copenhagen Hotel Palads. It was brought here by the Norwegian painter Per Krogh and his French wife Lucy Vidil - they gave a show so extraordinary that it was reported in the press! Do help us to live up to that today!
